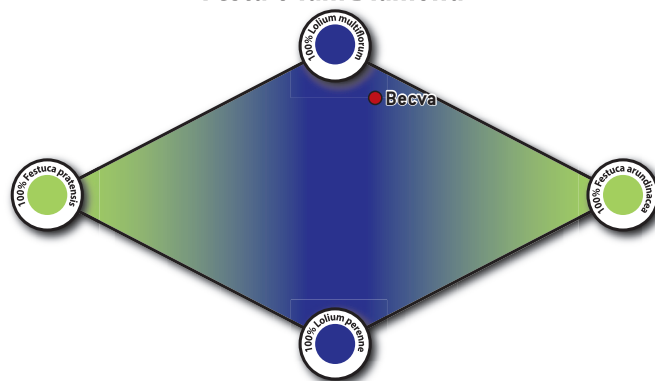
Becva is a tetraploid (4n) festulolium, combining the high yield and forage quality of Italian ryegrass with improved persistence from the tall fescue component.

Usage

Becva can be used when additional persistence is required over Italian ryegrass, without giving up dry matter yield. It suits as component in pasture mixtures, short-term pasture and hay field, overseeding of pastures and interseeding of alfalfa.

In festulolium forage trials in MI, Becva was the top DM yield per acre in seeding year 2014, plus the two following years 2015, 2016, showing its persistence.
