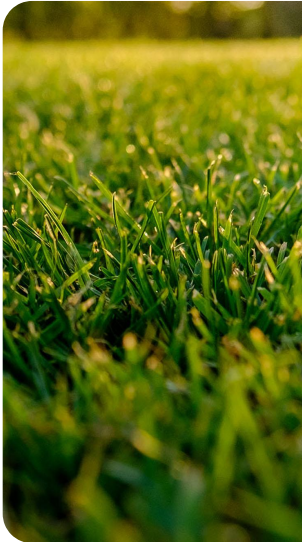

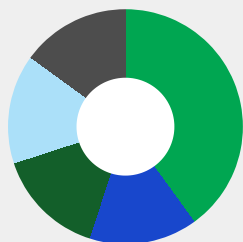


This advanced spreading technology leads to turfgrass with greater density and persistence, as well as improved wear tolerance and recovery.
